POLICIES AND FEES

K-2 is for children two years old on September 1, 2010. The class meets 2 days a week. The class has 12 children with a teacher and a full-time assistant, and meets from 8:30-11:30 or, with an additional fee, 8:30-1:45. Children may come in diapers or pull-ups. There are diaper changing facilities available, and children are helped with toilet use when ready.

K-3 is for children three years old on September 1, 2010. Classes meet either 3 days a week or 2 days a week. Each class has 16 children with a teacher and a full-time assistant, and meets from 8:30-11:30 or with an additional fee 8:30-1:45. Children may not come in diapers or pull-ups. Changing facilities are not available. Children are encouraged to toilet independently.

There is a 10% reduction in tuition for each child to families with more than one child in K-2 & K-3.

VPK meets Monday, Wednesday and Friday 8:15-1:45, with 18 children, a teacher and a full-time assistant. There is no wrap-around time or fees. The longer day allows for the same required VPK hours as the 5-day class. The children follow the same basic curriculum, leading to the meeting of Florida VPK standards for kindergarten readiness, as the 5-day class. The children bring their lunch from home.

VPK- EXTRA

VPK – EXTRA (VPKX) meets Monday- Friday, from 8:30-12:00 with an EXTRA half-hour wrap-around daily and a monthly fee of \$45. These EXTRA 42 hours a year give us an opportunity to build on the already strong foundation of VPK. The children will be involved in Clubs with small group activities that may include drama, music, art, cooking, yoga, photography and gymnastics. All of the EXTRA activities will help the children meet the Florida VPK standards for kindergarten readiness, and add EXTRA fun, too! VPK-EXTRA – PLUS (VPKX+) is an extension of this class to 1:45 for a wrap-around fee of \$140 per month.
